Recipe for August

Tomato salsa

5 large beef tomatoes

1 fresh red chilli, finely diced (if you do not want a HOT salsa then remove chilli seeds)

1/2 red onion

50grams fresh coriander

Juice of 1 lime

Salt & pepper to season

Optional oregano and cumin to taste.



Finely dice the tomatoes and put in a mixing bowl. Add diced chilli, then add chopped red onion to the bowl. Next, add the lime juice and season with

salt & pepper. Add oregano and cumin if using. Let the salsa sit for an hour allowing the flavours to combine.

As we are now in summertime !!! (we hope) some garlic bread with this salsa on top is a lovely snack to enjoy with a glass of wine.

Another salsa to try:- dice your tomatoes; chop an onion (red or white); finely chop some peeled cucumber; chop a clove of garlic; add 1 tbsp of olive oil and 1dessert spoon balsamic vinegar: Stir in a bowl and then tear fresh basil leaves into the mixture. Add salt & pepper and leave to stand for an hour.
