Thanks for the kind gesture though, Mike and Linda. It is much appreciated.


## Recipe for August

### Tomato salsa

5 large beef tomatoes

1 fresh red chilli, finely diced (if you do not want a HOT salsa then remove chilli seeds)

1/2 red onion
50grams fresh coriander
Juice of 1 lime
Salt & pepper to season
Optional oregano and cumin to taste.



salt & pepper. Add oregano and cumin if using. Let the salsa sit for an hour allowing the flavours to combine.

As we are now in summertime !!! (we hope ) some garlic bread with this salsa on top is a lovely snack to enjoy with a glass of wine.

Another salsa to try:- dice your tomatoes; chop an onion (red or white); finely chop some peeled cucumber; chop a clove of garlic; add 1 tbsp of olive oil and 1 dessert spoon balsamic vinegar: Stir in a bowl and then tear fresh basil leaves into the mixture. Add salt & pepper and leave to stand for an hour.
