

#### BRAMSHALL AND DISTRICT GARDENING CLUB

Following the summer break, Bramshall Gardening Club will resume its regular monthly meetings (set to the last Monday of the month) on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> September. This will be the start of the season 2016-2017, so new membership cards will be available. The cost of membership will be £13.00 for the period Sept 2016 to April 2017 and £6.50 for those who have already paid for the remainder of this year.

Otherwise, attendance for individual evenings is £3.00.

Joining for the year is doubly worthwhile. This is because, as well as the opportunity to enjoy interesting and informative meetings, Gardening Club members are able to enjoy a 10% discount at the Strawberry Garden Centre on purchases above £10 (excluding discounted items) on presentation of the Membership Card.

At the last Gardening Club meeting, we were pleased to have Mick Poultney speaking on a much less tiring form of gardening based on using raised beds. This does away with the need for digging to enhance the quality of the soil and can produce spectacular results, as demonstrated in Mick's presentation slides. The beds can be better managed than when normal beds are used and they warm up quicker, producing earlier crops. Mick was also an expert on different sorts of natural fertiliser, including beetle dung and mycorrhizal fungi, and had samples available for purchase.

For the next meeting at Bramshall Parish Hall is on Monday 26<sup>th</sup> September at 7:45pm. Ron Rock will present a highly-acclaimed presentation wittily entitled 'Beguiled by Bees'.

## <u>Recipe for September</u>

CARBONARA (really quick)

*I love an easy recipe that can be made when you have those days and wonder what on earth you can rustle up quickly ...* 

4 tablespoons Parmigiano Raggiano cheese (Parmesan) -fully grated 2 eggs plus 2 extra yolks

225g Linguine or Spaghetti ( I always buy fresh pasta but dried works just as well)

4 tablespoons half fat crème fraiche or double cream (or 2 tbsp. of each) 100g of crispy fried smoked bacon

Cook pasta in boiling, salted water for 10minutes.

Meanwhile, whisk the eggs plus yolks, cheese and crème fraiche/ cream in a bowl and season with salt & pepper - not too much salt but plenty of pepper. When the pasta is cooked, drain quickly in a colander leaving a little of the moisture still clinging. Quickly return pasta to the saucepan and add the chopped, smoked crispy bacon followed by the egg mixture.

Stir very thoroughly so that everything gets a good coating. The liquid eggs cook briefly as it mixes with the hot pasta. If in doubt, I put the pan on a low heat to give a boost of heat. However, if you have used fresh cream don't boil as it will separate.

Serve on hot, deep plates with lots of grated Parmesan cheese. I hope you enjoy this dish. For me it does work - even better - with a nice glass of red wine!!!


With universal charm, the band will warm to any setting and win over audiences young and old with their tremendously impassioned performance and authentic demeanor.
