Chicken Korma

Ingredients:2 Chicken breasts. I med onion,
1 clove garlic (optional).
1/2 jar Korma paste, 50ml water.
Coconut cream
50ml double cream.

Stir the mixture of oil.



Heat oil in a pan and when warm add chopped onion, cook until soft. Add 1/2 jar of Pataks korma paste cook for 1-2mins. Add 50ml of water and finely chopped clove of garlic. Cook until water has evaporated. Add 500g diced chicken, cook until sealed. Once chicken sealed put in small tin of coconut cream. Taste and if you want more curry flavour I add teaspoon of curry powder but remember Korma is fairly mild. After cooking for 15mins put the curry into a serving dish and drizzle with double cream and fresh chopped coriander. Serve with boiled rice and Naan bread.

If you like Indian food then use same method using Tikka Masala paste. I find paste much better than jars of ready-made sauces. However I hope you enjoy the above.
