#### **BRAMSHALL AND DISTRICT GARDENING CLUB**

We were pleased to welcome BBC West Midlands' 'Laughing Gardener', Darren Rudge, for the opening meeting of the season. He lived up to his nickname as plenty of humour was included in his presentation as well as some very useful information. He said that never before has there been so many ornamental plants available to gardeners and much consideration should be given as to how well they would fit into the situations which our gardens offer – considering, for instance, soil type, availability of sun and water and how much maintenance would be required.

Sometimes it is possible to tell the conditions which a plant will favour – plants with big glossy leaves will like shady situations (glossy leaves reflect light) and plants with grey leaves thrive in dry conditions (for instance, Lavender). He gave a list of what he called 'Bomb proof Plants', which can cope with more severe garden environments than most and had colourful flowers or foliage and, for the densest shade, he recommended *Sweet Woodruff* which is actually a wild flower but creates a carpet of white scented flowers in these difficult places. The presentation slides were excellent and Darren's commentary gave everyone some new ideas and approaches to create a successful garden.

The October meeting of the new season will be at Bramshall Parish Hall on Monday 28<sup>th</sup> October at 7:30pm. Kath Reynolds will be presenting 'Famous Folk from Stoke' which has had some very good reviews. For November, on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> November, we look forward to a very humorous and instructive talk on 'Garden Mishaps and Disasters' from the National Garden Scheme exhibitors Graham and Judy White.

And here is one of the cake recipes for you to try at home.

#### All in One Jam and Cream Sponge

110g self raising flour	1 level tsp baking powder
110g soft margarine	110g caster sugar
2 eggs	2 – 3 drops vanilla essence

Grease and line 2 x 18cm round cake tins. Combine all ingredients in a mixing bowl and whisk about 1 minute. Divide the mixture between the 2 tins, level off and bake around 30 minutes in a warm oven 170°C. When cooked they will be springy to touch. Turn out and cool on a wire rack with paper removed.

To finish layer with a sandwich of jam (we used seedless raspberry) and whipped fresh cream. Sprinkle the top with icing sugar.

### Penny's Recipe of the Month

Sausage Pie.

11b sausage meat, 1 onion, 1 cooking apple. 1-2 tomatoes. Potatoes.



Slice onion and fry in pan until soft. remove from pan then fry sausage meet and when cooked put in a dish then add a layer of onion. Peel and slice the cooking apple and layer on top of the sausage meat, then add a layer of sliced tomato. Peel potatoes and put in saucepan and then boil when cooked slice potatoes and then place on top of the meat, onion, apple, and tomato. Heat oven to 375deg and cook put in oven for 40mins.

Well we are now in October and Autumn is here the leaves are turning and the Horse Chestnut trees are shedding their conkers, which I collect and put in each room by the windows to stop spiders from coming in whilst I can't guarantee 100% success it does work well. Also at his time of year I love cooking casseroles thing like carbonnade of beef, beef slow cooked in red wine, coq au vin, cottage pie, cauliflower cheese - all good food and not expensive to do. I hope you enjoy the above recipe of sausage pie.
